IForomo LemVumo: IPhephambuzo LamaKhaya

Iphephambuzo lizakunikelwa umuntu omdala kunabo boke ekhaya kanye / namkha elinye ilunga lomndeni elazi ngcono ngamahlelo wokuphila kanye nokusetjenziswa kweemali ngekhaya. Nanyana ukuzibandakanya kwamanye amalunga womndeni kukhuthazwa, iforomo lemvumo leli kufanele litlikitlwe *ngomkhulu* ophendulako.

Leli lipheno ngesibumbeko samakhaya kanye nokuthuthela kwezinye iindawo, ingeniso yamakhaya kanye nokusetjenziswa kweemali, zokuqatjiswa kanye nokungena isikolo eSewula Afrika. Lephrojekthi yenziwa barhubhululi beYunivesithi yeKapa ngokuyenzela i-Ofisi lakaMongameli leSewula Afrika. Umnqopho kufunda khulu ngokobana abantu beSewula Afrika baphila njani ngokukhamba kwesikhathi.

Njengehlangothi lephenyo, sizakubawa ukubuza elinye nelinye ilunga lomndeni imibuzo. Ngaphambi kwalokho sizakubawa usinikele ilwazi elisisekelo ngekhaya lakho, elifana nokobana ngubani ovamise ukuhlala lapho, ukobana uyayifikelela imisebenzi efana namanzi negezi na begodu nokobana ngiyiphi ipahla onayo.

Ngaphambi kokuthoma kokubuzwa imibuzo, sifuna ukwenza isiqiniseko sokobana uzwisisa ilwazi elilandelako ngephenyo:

- Ukuzibandakanya kwakho kuya ngokuzithandela. Ungala ukuzibandakanya ekubuzweni imibuzo begodu ungalisa ngesinye nesinye isikhathi nayikuthi awufuni ukuragela phambili. Godu unelungelo lokweqa eminye imibuzo namkha umbuzo nayikuthi awufisi ukuyiphendula.
- Isikhathi ozasithatha ukuphetha ukubuzwa imibuzo sizakuya ngokobana bangaki abantu abahlala ekhaya lakho nokobana zoke iingaba zephephambuzo zikhambelana nekhaya lakho na, kodwana inani elilingeneko kuzakuba mizuzu ema-40.
- Unelungelo lokubuza imibuzo ngesinye nesinye isikhathi ngaphambi, ngesikhathi sokubuzwa imibuzo namkha ngemva kokubuzwa kokuphela kokubuzwa imibuzo.
- Loke ilwazi elibuthelelwe ephenyweni lizakuba yifihlo ekulu. Nanyana idatha ebuthelelweko izakusetjenziselwa iminqopho yerhubhululo, ilwazi elingakuveza namkha ikhaya lakho angeze lavezwa tihatjhalaza komunye nomunye umbiko werhubhululo namkha womtlo.
- Ihloso yephenyo kukwenza okhunye ukubuza imibuzo okuragela phambili ngomuso. Ngebanga lalokhu, imininingwana engawe izakugcinwa khona uzakuthintwa butjha emaphenyweni wangomuso abumba iphrojekthi le. Kodwana, sizakubawa imvumo yakho bona uzibandakanye ephenyweni godu ngesinye nesinye isikhathi. Ukuvuma ukuzibandakanya akutjho bonyana kufanele uzibandakanye emaphenyweni wangomuso.

Ngokutlikitla ngenzasi, utjengisa bona uyavuma ukuzibandakanya ephenyweni begodu ukuzibandakanya kwakho kuya ngokuzithandela.

Consent Form: Household Questionnaire

This questionnaire is to be administered to the oldest woman in the household and/or another household member who is knowledgeable about the living arrangements and spending patterns of the household. While participation from other household members is encouraged, this consent form should be signed by the *main* respondent.

This is a study about household composition and migration, household income and expenditure, employment and schooling in South Africa. This project is run by researchers at the University of Cape Town on behalf of the South African Presidency. The purpose of this study is to learn more about how people in South Africa are faring over time.

As part of this study we will be asking to interview each member of this household. Before we do that, we will be asking you to provide some background information about your household, such as who usually lives here, whether you have access to services such as water and electricity and which assets you own.

Before we begin the interview, we want to make sure you understand the following information about the study:

- Your participation is entirely voluntary. You may refuse to take part in the interview, and you may stop at any time if you do not want to continue. You also have the right to skip any particular question or questions if you do not wish to answer them.
- The time it takes to complete the interview will vary depending on how many people live in your household and whether all the sections of the questionnaire are relevant to your household, but the average amount of time for this interview is 40 minutes.
- You have the right to ask questions at any point before the interview, during the interview, or after the interview is completed.
- All information collected for this study will be kept strictly confidential. While the data collected will be used for research purposes, information that could identify you or your household will never be publicly released in any research report or publication.
- The intention of the study is to conduct further interviews with you in the future. As a result, your personal details will be kept on record in order that you can be re-contacted to participate in future studies that form part of this project. However, we will ask your permission to participate in the survey again each time. Agreeing to participate now does not mean you have to participate in future surveys.
